Prepare and present periodic reports to the USPFO SMO or Deputy USPFO about Commercial Transportation planning requirements for deployment, redeployment, and training set movement. Make recommendations on NENG goals that shall become the foundation for short and long range planning and how to make the Commercial Transportation Branch operational. Serve as the technical transportation subject matter expert to all statewide operating officials on all matters dealing with commercial movement of personnel and equipment.

**Major responsibilities include (not all inclusive):**

- Make recommendations concerning the Commercial Transportation Planning Process for all aspects of planning and implementation
- Provide Periodic progress reports or briefings as required by the SMO
- Collaborate with other managers and staff members in order to formulate and implement policies, procedures, goals and objectives. Assist and facilitates working groups that lead to the determination of the Goals of the NENG
- Provide recommendations to the SMO and Deputy USPFO
- Ensure goals are consistent with National and State military strategies and local limitations
- Ensure goals consider nontraditional missions such as flooding, disaster relief and (de)mobilization
- Assist in developing key indicators for monitoring commercial transportation goals
- Implement a process that effectively and efficiently tracks and reports the status of the key indicators and that measures progress toward the established goals
- Receive Orders (Mission or Warning), and shall provide a report to Supply Management detailing conflicts, between goals, requirements, available assets and missions
- Prepare Supply Management plan reports, graphs, and charts. Maintain records depicting current and future Supply Management goals and objectives
- Evaluate agency program performance against stated goals by compiling, organizing, and analyzing data and assisting in the development of trend analysis

**Qualified candidates must have:**

- Desired Bachelor's degree or demonstrated practical experience in the area of expertise required by the Task Order
- Provide technical support to supporting and deploying units
- Supply purchase request status and maintain accountable balances
- Determine excess and processes request, turn-ins and receipts
- Assist customers with inquiries regarding supply/logistics and technical questions
- Provide supervision to the supply operation of the warehouse. A minimum of five years experience required
- Knowledge to plan and accomplish a variety of complex work assignments and/or identify problems and be able to analyze and resolve transportation issues or problems
- Knowledge of the capability and limitations of various modes of transportation to include rail, highway, air and sea. Knowledge of related mode configurations to contract proper means of transportation
- Knowledge to plan and direct the installation operation for the movement of vehicles, equipment, conventional ammunition, and materials via most feasible method available (air, rail, truck or vessel/barge)
- Ability to pass any necessary background investigations, with a minimum NAC clearance
- Proficiency in Microsoft Word, Excel, Power Point and Database use experience
