LINCOLN, Neb. – Approximately 30 Nebraska National Guardsmen will be honored by Gov. Dave Heineman and Maj. Gen. Roger Lempke tomorrow, Feb. 13, during a recognition ceremony to be held in the Warner Chamber of the Nebraska State Capitol Building. The ceremony is scheduled to begin at 1 p.m.

The ceremony is designed to honor those Nebraska National Guard members who made the ultimate sacrifice for the nation as well as those Guard members who received the Bronze Star Medal with Valor, the Purple Heart or the Army Commendation Medal with Valor during the past year.

According to event organizers, approximately 20 of the 30 eligible Guard members will be in attendance during the ceremony.

Due to limited seating, the ceremony is not open to the public.
