LINCOLN, Neb. – Eight members of the Lincoln-based 111th Press Camp Headquarters, Nebraska Army National Guard, will be wished farewell, tomorrow, July 20, at 2:30 p.m. at the Penterman Armory on the National Guard air base in Lincoln, Neb., as the Soldiers begin final training for a mission that will ultimately take them to Kosovo.

While in Kosovo, the Nebraska Army National Guard print and broadcast journalists will be responsible for a wide-array of public affairs missions including producing a base magazine for American and Coalition forces and working with local, national and international journalists.

The Soldiers will be formally wished farewell during a ceremony scheduled to begin at 2:30 p.m. at the Penterman Armory located at the National Guard air base in Lincoln. Among the state and local leaders expected to speak during the ceremony are Lt. Gov. Rick Sheehy and Brig. Gen. Bill Kuehn. Following the ceremony, the Soldiers will deploy to Camp Atterbury, Ind., for final training before ultimately deploying to Kosovo later this year. The deployment is scheduled to last one year.

Due to space constraints, the farewell ceremony is not open to the public.
